**SHIKANJVI**

(A long, cool glass of sweetened fresh limewater with just enough spice to ignite your taste buds)

**MALAI WALI LASSI**

(A sweetened chilled yoghurt drink, topped with clotted cream)

**AAM PANNA**

(A refreshing drink made with raw mangoes and spices)

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**PAPRI CHAAT**

(A refreshing combination of crisp semolina and flour chips covered in chilled yoghurt, chutneys, ginger and hot spices)

**GOL GAPPE**

(Fried puffed up semolina or wheat flour balls, served filled with chickpeas, boiled potatoes and tangy water)

**FRUIT CHAAT**

(Fresh seasonal fruits tossed with cumin, chaat masala and lemon juice)

**SHAKARKANDI KI CHAAT**

(Roasted sweet potato and star fruit tossed in mint and coriander chutney flavoured with rock salt)

**SAMOSE CHHOLE KI CHAAT**

(Carom seed flavoured, triangular patties, stuffed with potatoes and deep-fried. Served with masala chickpeas and chutney)

**AJWAINI SURMAI**

(Fried dard of king fish, marinated with lime, carom seeds and spices served with mooli salad and mint chutney)

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**BUTTER CHICKEN**

(Tandoori chicken, simmered in rich ginger and fenugreek flavoured tomato sauce – a Punjabi dish adopted as its own by Delhi)

**RARA MEAT**

(Tender lamb chunks pot roasted with peppercorn flavoured spicy masala)

CHHOLE BHATURE

(Chickpeas cooked in a spicy tangy masala with green chillies, ginger, tomatoes and spring onion. Served with two bhaturas)

DAL MAA RAJMA

(Dal urad black and kidney beans, simmered overnight with spices and finished with tomato puree and kasuri methi)

PARANTHE WALI GALLI

(Shallow fried flat breads with choice of stuffing like potatoes, cottage cheese, peas or cauliflower. Served with pickle and raita)

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GAJAR KA HALWA

(Rich grated carrot and milk pudding topped with nuts)

MATKE WALI KULFI

(Indian ice cream in earthen pot)
